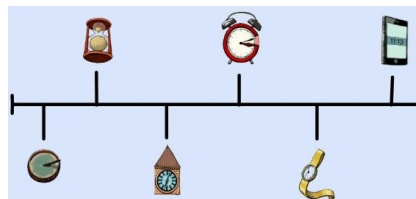





To finish off the year and our Journey Through Time we will explore Before and Beyond, looking at times before 1900 and also at what may come in the future.
